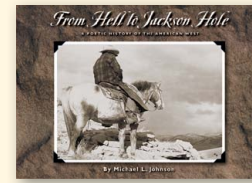

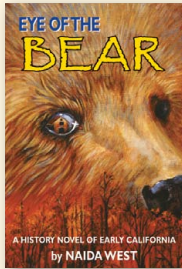

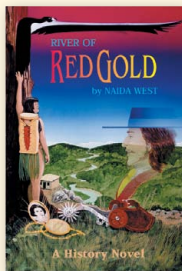
## Eye of the Bear: A History Novel of Early California - by Naida West

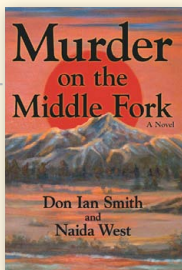
